124 credits. All remedial coursework must be completed prior to enrolling in FASH 120, 121. Fashion Design Majors are required to make a "C" or better in all DSGN, FASH, and VIAR courses. Minimum "C" required in MATH 100/105.

- 1 SCI elective. Any BIOL/RRES 150, PHYS, CHEM, GEOL; six hours must be in a single biological (BIOL) or physical (CHEM, PHYS, GEOL) science, and three hours in the remaining natural science area not chosen. Every student must take a BIOL/RRES 150 course to graduate.
- 2 BHSC elective. Any ANTH, ECON, GEOG, POLS, PSYC, SOCI, CJUS; three hours must be at 200+ level.
- 3 CMCN elective. Select from CMCN 101, 200, 222, 242, 310, 322, ENGL 360, 365, THEA 261.
- 4 LIT elective. Any one course in ENGL or MODL that focuses on literary texts, i.e., poetry, fiction, drama, or essay; does not include linguistics or language courses.
- 5 HIST elective. Any course in HIST except 390.
- 6 Notebook computer required for class.
- 7 MATH elective. Select one from MATH 110 and above, or STAT 214 and above.
