<sup>2</sup> BHSC elective. Six hours chosen from the following (three hours must be 200 level or above): ANTH 201, 202, 303, 310; PSYC 110, 210, 311, 312; SOCI 100, 241, 310, 325, 395; ECON 201, 202, 310; GEOG 102, 103, 201, 286, 310, 322, 400G; POLS 110, 120, 302, 312, 317, 382, 396; CJUS 101.

<sup>3</sup> CMCN elective. Can be either CMCN 200, 310; ENGL 223, 365; THEA 261. International students must take CMCN 101.

<sup>4</sup> LIT elective. From ENGL 201, 202, 203, 204, 205, 206, 216, or a foreign language literature.

<sup>5</sup> HIST elective. Can be chosen from any 300-400 level HIST except 390 and 410G.

<sup>6</sup> Notebook computer required for class.

<sup>7</sup> VIAR/SOAD elective. Must be selected from the School of Architecture and Design and 300-400 level; either ARCH, FASH, INDS, INDN. With advisor approval may be selected from VIAR with three hours VIAR history.

<sup>8</sup> MKTG/MGMT elective. From MKTG 260, 345, MGMT 230, 300, 320.

<sup>9</sup> Consult with advisor.
